- Jeff enabled a national bank client and its participant lender to recover full repayment of a distressed, \$29 million loan secured by multiple nursing homes. He helped achieve this by working cooperatively with the borrower (while also aggressively and successfully motivating it) to effectuate multiple sale and refinancing transactions that gradually paid down and ultimately satisfied the debt.
- Jeff navigated a borrower through a hotly-contested Chapter 11 reorganization, which included convincing the court to approve the client's use of the lender's cash collateral

(despite the lender's opposition). Ultimately, the court confirmed a Chapter 11 plan where the client's business was sold as a going concern, which maximized its creditors' recoveries, preserved its employees' jobs, and allowed the business to continue.
